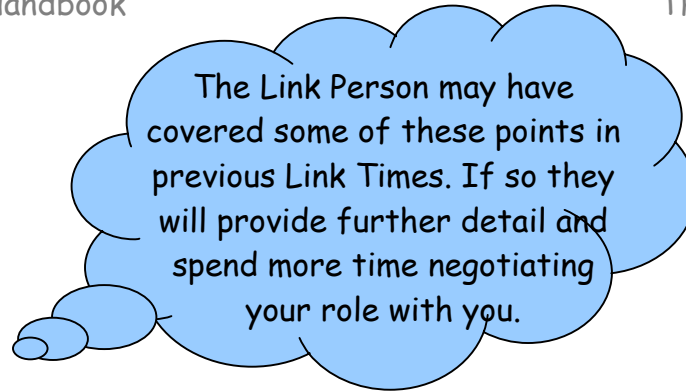

- How this work influences what happens in the service

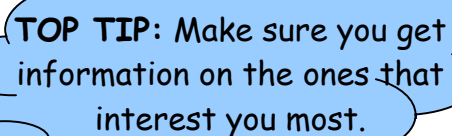
